In most cases we will need your consent in order to use cookies on this website.

We may use cookies without your consent where the cookies are essential for the functioning of our site and in order to provide our services to you. For example, this will apply where:

In order to check out for any purchases made on the Site; in order to ensure that goods remain in your basket once a selection has been made by you on the site, to manage and adapt your personalised greeting on the Site.

Where we wish to use cookies that require your consent you will be asked whether you consent to the use of cookies in the following manner:

Users shall be required to consent through a checkbox pop-up on the website homepage that they will need to answer in order to gain full access to the website.

Wherever you have given your consent to the use of cookies, you will be able to optout and withdraw your consent by:

A banner will be shown to all users who have consented to cookies being used, which will ask them if they wish to opt-out of the use of such technologies.

We will not allow any third parties access to the cookies we use.

This website, built using the Wix website builder, uses cookies and similar technologies to enhance user experience, track website performance, and support functionality. Some of the cookies used include:

WixSession: Maintains user session information and keeps users logged in while navigating the site.

XSRF-TOKEN: Protects against cross-site request forgery (CSRF) attacks to ensure secure data submission.

wix.com: Used for site functionality, including remembering user preferences, language settings, and customisations.

smk.: Tracks user behavior for analytics purposes, helping improve site performance and user experience.

AWSELB / AWSELBCORS: Ensures users are connected to the correct server for optimal performance during their session.

wixLanguage: Stores language preferences to deliver content in the user's chosen language.

Tawk.to Cookies: Tracks chat sessions and maintains continuity for users if live chat is integrated.

These cookies help improve the site's functionality and performance while providing a personalised experience.

Retention periods for cookies

The period of time which cookies shall be stored for shall be dependant upon the type of cookie used. There are two broad categories of cookies:

- session cookies which are temporary and are erased each time you close your browser. Session cookies are used to remember your actions between one page and another during a browsing session.
- Persistent cookies which remain on your browser until you delete them or until they expire.

We set out below our retention periods for our use of persistent cookies.

(Name of cookie - retention period)

For a website built using Wix, the retention period of persistent cookies varies based on their function: Wix's own cookies, such as those used for session management and user preferences (e.g., wix.com, wixLanguage), are typically retained for up to 2 years. Security cookies like XSRF-TOKEN are usually session-based or last up to 1 hour, while Wix's analytics cookies (smk.) are stored for up to 2 years. Cookies from third-party services integrated into the site, like Google Analytics (up to 2 years), HubSpot (up to 13 months), and Tawk.to (up to 2 years), may also be used, with retention periods varying depending on the service. Cookies for performance (e.g., AWSELB), security (e.g., Cloudflare), or video (e.g., Vimeo and YouTube) typically persist for up to 1 year or 2 years.
